Reference is made to your application dated March 10, 1989, for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Hancock "A" Well No. 708 or 710 to be located 2595 feet from the North line and 685 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 26, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
