Dear Mr. Sanders:

Reference is made to your application dated September 13, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Burch "C" Federal Well No. 48 to be located 1310 feet from the South line and 2070 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg - Jackson Pool, Phillips Burch - Keely Cooperative Waterflood Project Area (which was authorized by Division Order No. R-7900), Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 23.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F.(1), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
