Reference is made to your application dated November 6, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your SMGSAU Tract 6 Well No. 8 to be located 125 feet from the South line and 1345 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Southeast Maljamar Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
