Reference is made to your application dated January 20, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your SMGSAU Tract 1 Well No. 6 to be located 330 feet from the South line and 50 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Southeast Maljamar Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico, said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 30.
