Reference is made to your application dated March 16, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington Paddock Unit Well No. 141 to be located 2545 feet from the North line and 1440 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lovington Paddock Pool, Lovington Paddock Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
