Dear Mr. Libersat:

Reference is made to your applications dated September 18, 1991 for two non-standard coal gas well locations to be drilled in Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

- 1) The Rosa Unit Well No. 341 to be located 2315 feet from the South line and 2335 feet from the West line in Unit K and shall be dedicated to the 320-acres comprising the W/2 of said Section 11.
- 2) The Rosa Unit Well No. 342 to be located 765 feet from the North line and 2595 feet from the East line in Unit B and shall be dedicated to the 320-acres comprising the E/2 of said Section 11.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above described unorthodox coal gas well locations are hereby approved.
