Reference is made to your application dated June 17, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for a well to be drilled 920 feet from the South line and 1095 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Artesia Queen Grayburg San Andres Pool, Grayburg - Ibex Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 21.
