
Dear Ms. Johnston:

Reference is made to your application dated May 21, 1992 for a non-standard Atoka gas well location for the existing State Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 11, Township 11 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, whereby the N/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

It is our understanding that the subject well was originally drilled to a total depth of 10,632 feet to the test the Mississippian and Pennsylvanian formations in April 1952 by Lawton Oil Corporation. In August 1952 said well was dry abandoned.

At this time, the applicant has made a proper filing pursuant to Division General Rule 104.F(3) and (4), also no objections have been received during the required 20-day waiting period. Therefore, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
