Dear Mr. Greer:

Reference is made to your application dated August 12, 1992 for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location in an existing non-standard 240-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising the E/2 NE/4 of Section 11 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 12, both in, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-573, dated January 13, 1955 and presently has dedicated thereon the H.W. Andrews Well No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 12.


It is my understanding that the subject well in this application is temporarily abandoned in the Eunice Monument Grayburg San Andres Pool and upon issuance of this order will be recompleted in the Eumont Gas Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.

H.W. Andrews Well No. 3  
1980' FNL - 660' FEL (Unit H)  
of Section 11

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the H.W. Andrews Well No. 1 with the H.W. Andrews Well No. 3. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from both said wells in any proportion.
