

Dear Mr. Breining:

Reference is made to your application dated September 17, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location for your State A-3 Well No. 1 to be located 2245 feet from the North line and 1505 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 3, Township 17 South, Range 17 East, NMPM, to test all formations from the surface to the top of the PreCambrian, Chaves County, New Mexico. The SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 3 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit within said vertical extent.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.(1) the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
