

Dear Ms. Wickham:

Reference is made to your application dated September 25, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient projection/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Artesia Metex Unit Well No. 63 to be located 1620 feet from the North line and 2500 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM Artesia Pool, Artesia Metex Unit Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 NE/4 of said Section 25 and is currently dedicated to the Artesia Metex Unit Well No. 39 located 2310 feet from the North and East lines.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.(1) and Division Order No. R-4609, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
