Dear Mr. Marshall:

Reference is made to your application dated September 22, 1992 for an unorthodox gas well location in the San Andres formation underlying the NW/4 of Section 26, Township 2 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the existing Stoltenberg Well No. 1, location 1650 feet from the North line and 2310 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 26, was recently re-entered and was completed as a gas well in the San Andres formation through the perforated interval 2920 feet to 2930 feet. The subject well was originally drilled in late 1986 to a total depth of 7290 feet to test the Montoya formation for gas. At that time, the N/2 of said Section 26 was to be dedicated to said well whereon the locations was considered standard for such completion.

The subject location however is considered non-standard pursuant to Division General Rule 104.B.(1)(a), at this time the applicant has made proper filing pursuant to Division General Rule 104.F.(3) and (4); therefore, the above described San Andres gas well location is hereby approved.
