

Dear Ms. Wickham:

Reference is made to your application dated September 25, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Artesia Metex Unit Well No. 62 to be located 2310 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Artesia Pool, Artesia Metex Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Lot 2, being the SW/4 NW/4 equivalent of said Section 30, is to be dedicated to said well forming a non-standard 43.30-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.(I) and Division Order No. R-4609, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
