Reference is made to your application dated November 5, 1992, on behalf of Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P., for a non-standard gas well location for the Lambchop "20" (Federal) Com Well No. 1 to be drilled 479 feet from the North line and 1814 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 20, Township 24 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Undesignated Mosley Canyon-Strawn Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 20 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(I) the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
