
Reference is made to your application dated February 24, 1993 on behalf of the operator, Meridian Oil, Inc., for an unorthodox Blanco Mesaverde gas well location in an existing standard 313.63-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Blanco Mesaverde Pool comprising Lots 1, 2, 7 through 10, 15 and 16 (E/2 equivalent) of Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Said GPU presently has dedicated thereon the Seymour Well No. 7 located at a standard gas well location in the NE/4 of said Section 23.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Seymour Well No. 7-A
425' FSL - 790' FEL (Unit P)

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Blanco Mesaverde gas production from the No. 7-A well with the No. 7 well. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from both of said wells in any proportion.
