

Dear Mr. Carter:

Reference is made to your application dated March 31, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your G-J West Coop Unit Well No. 120 to be located 2160 feet from the North line and 2615 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Grayburg Jackson Waterflood Project Area (established by Division Order No. R-3069), Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 21 currently dedicated to your G-J West Coop Unit Well No. 36 located 1980 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 21..

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(1) and Division Order No. R-7808, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
