Dear Mr. Stogner:

Pogo Producing Company ³ requests administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location, due to topographical conditions, for its State V-492 Well No. 2, located 1,980 feet FSL and 1,350 feet FWL (Unit K) of Section 27, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County. The well will be drilled to test the Atoka formation (Salt Draw-Atoka Gas Pool), and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 27 will be dedicated to the well. There is a possibility that the well will be drilled to the Morrow formation (undesignated Malaga-Morrow Pool), and as a result Pogo requests approval of the location for both the Atoka and Morrow formations.

If it is permissible, Pogo further requests approval of unorthodox locations for all other prospective pools or formations spaced on 40, 160, and 320 acres, which includes the Delaware, Bone Spring, Wolfcamp, and Strawn.

The proration unit includes State of New Mexico Lease V-492, which covers the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, and United States Lease NM 54857, which covers the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27. The well is located on the state lease. Attached as Exhibit A are Forms C-101 and C-102 containing the required information.

OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

The reasons for the proposed unorthodox location are as follows:

1. Referring to the topographic map attached as Exhibit B, please note that all orthodox drilling windows, except the one in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, are under Willow Lake.

2. Pogo originally proposed an orthodox location 1,980 feet FSL and FWL. However, the surface owner, IMC Fertilizer, has facilities near that location and requested that the well be moved to the north and/or west. In addition to IMC's facilities, moving to the east or south moves the well too close to Willow Lake. As a result, Pogo has selected a location 1,350 feet FWL. Moving closer to an orthodox location is difficult because of the steep slope for the interval from 1,350 feet FWL to 1,830 feet FWL, which prevents building a location. The location at 1,830 feet FWL is in a draw, and building a location there would impede natural drainage to Willow Lake. Furthermore, IMC requested the location be moved further west than 1830 feet FWL. There are no nearby well pads which can be used.

Directionally drilling this well to a standard bottomhole location is not feasible because it would add approximately \$270,000.00 to the cost of this well, which adds about 30% to the dry hole cost and adversely affects economics.

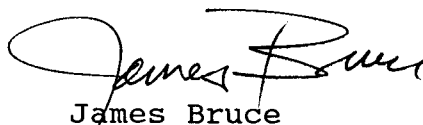
Attached as Exhibit C is a plat identifying offset operators or lessees. This information is current and correct. Notice of this application was sent to all offsetting operators, and they have all signed waivers, which are attached as Exhibit D. Please note that all offsets, besides waiving objection to the location, have waived the Division's 20 day notice period. As a result, we ask that the order be issued as soon as possible, due to the federal lease expiring on May 31, 1993.

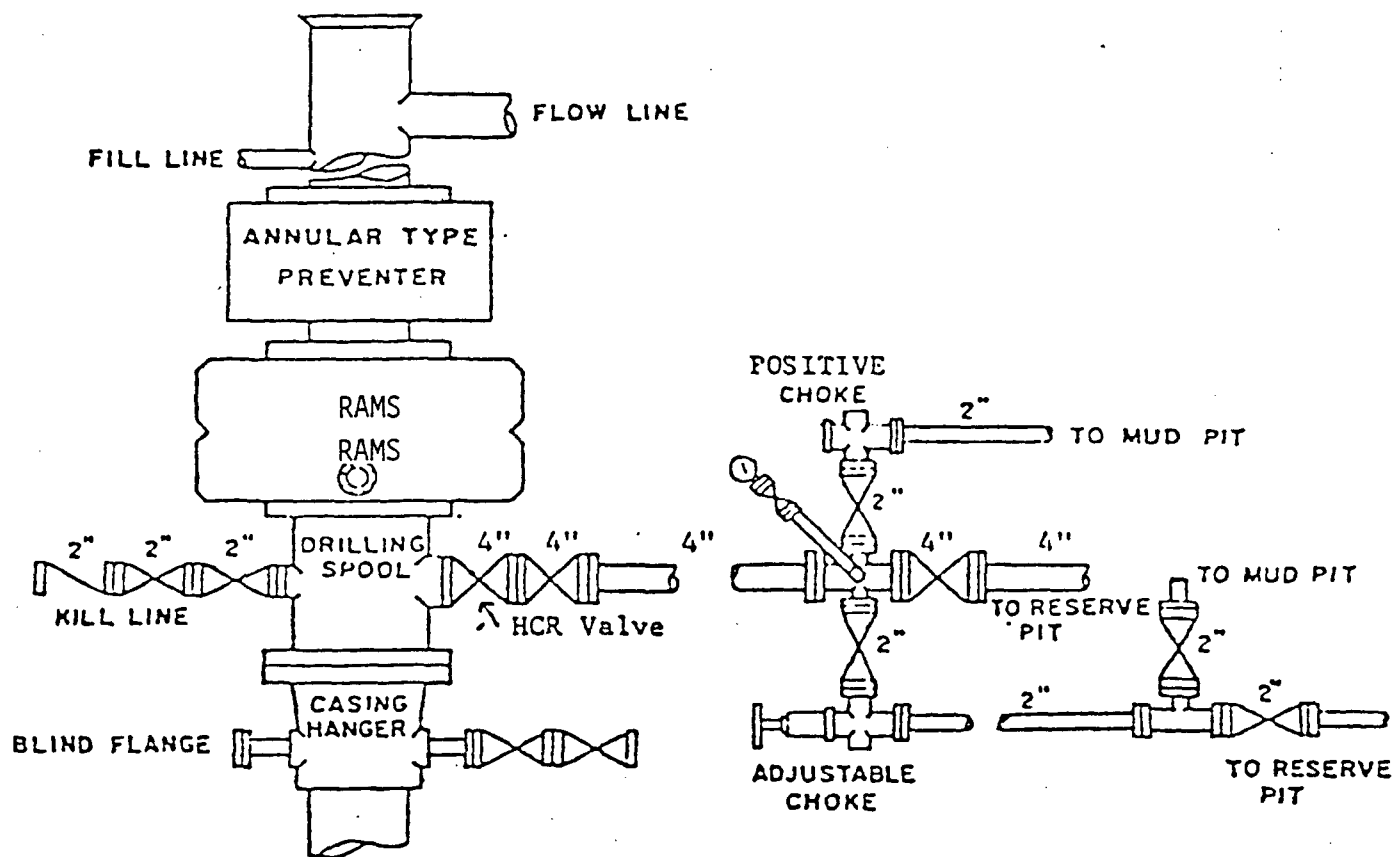


BOP STACK

BOP ARRANGEMENT

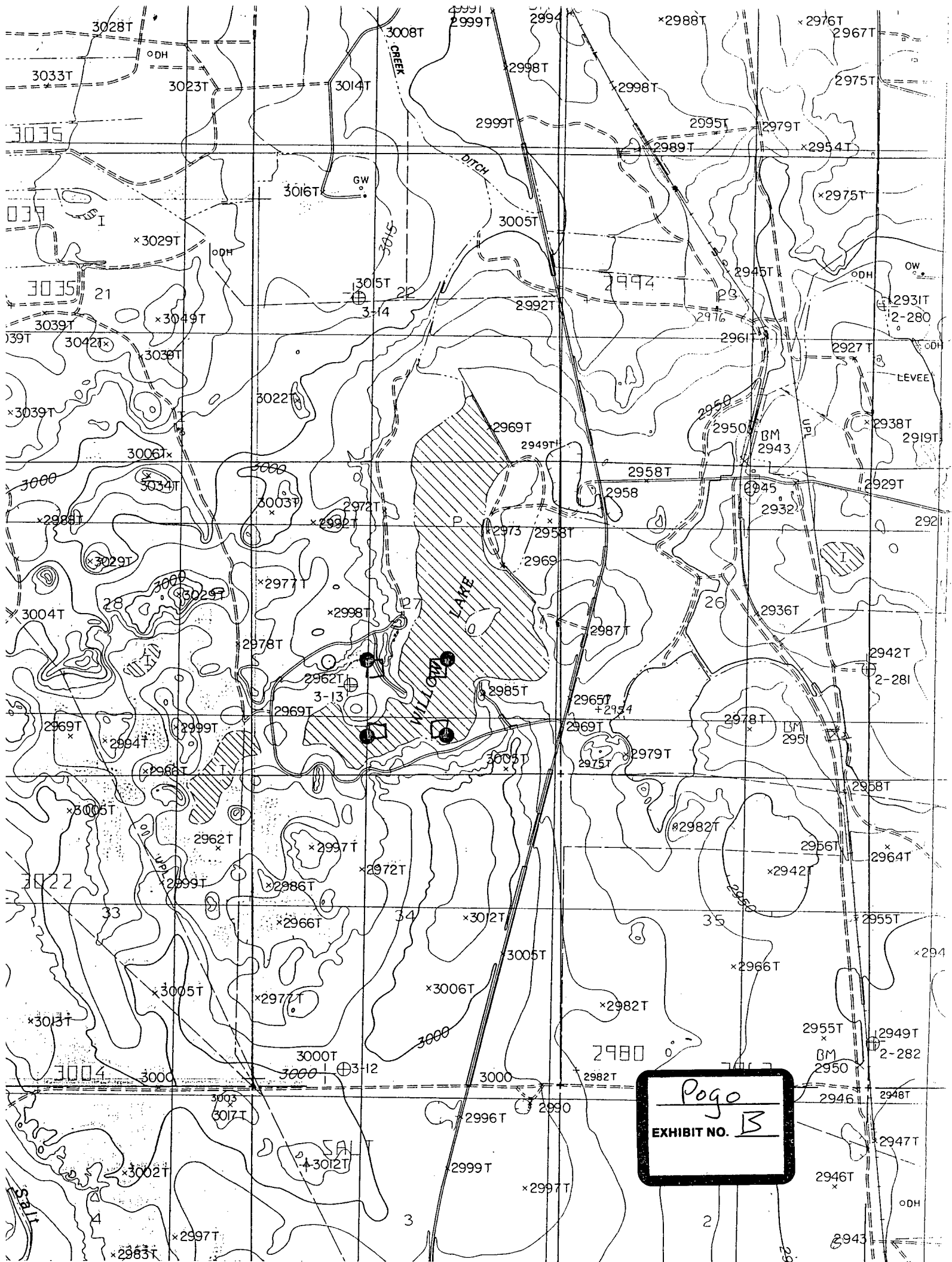


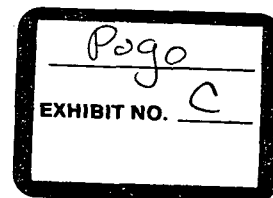
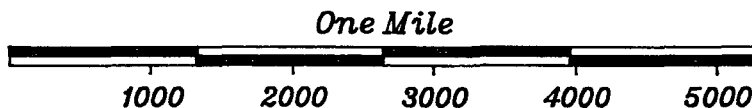
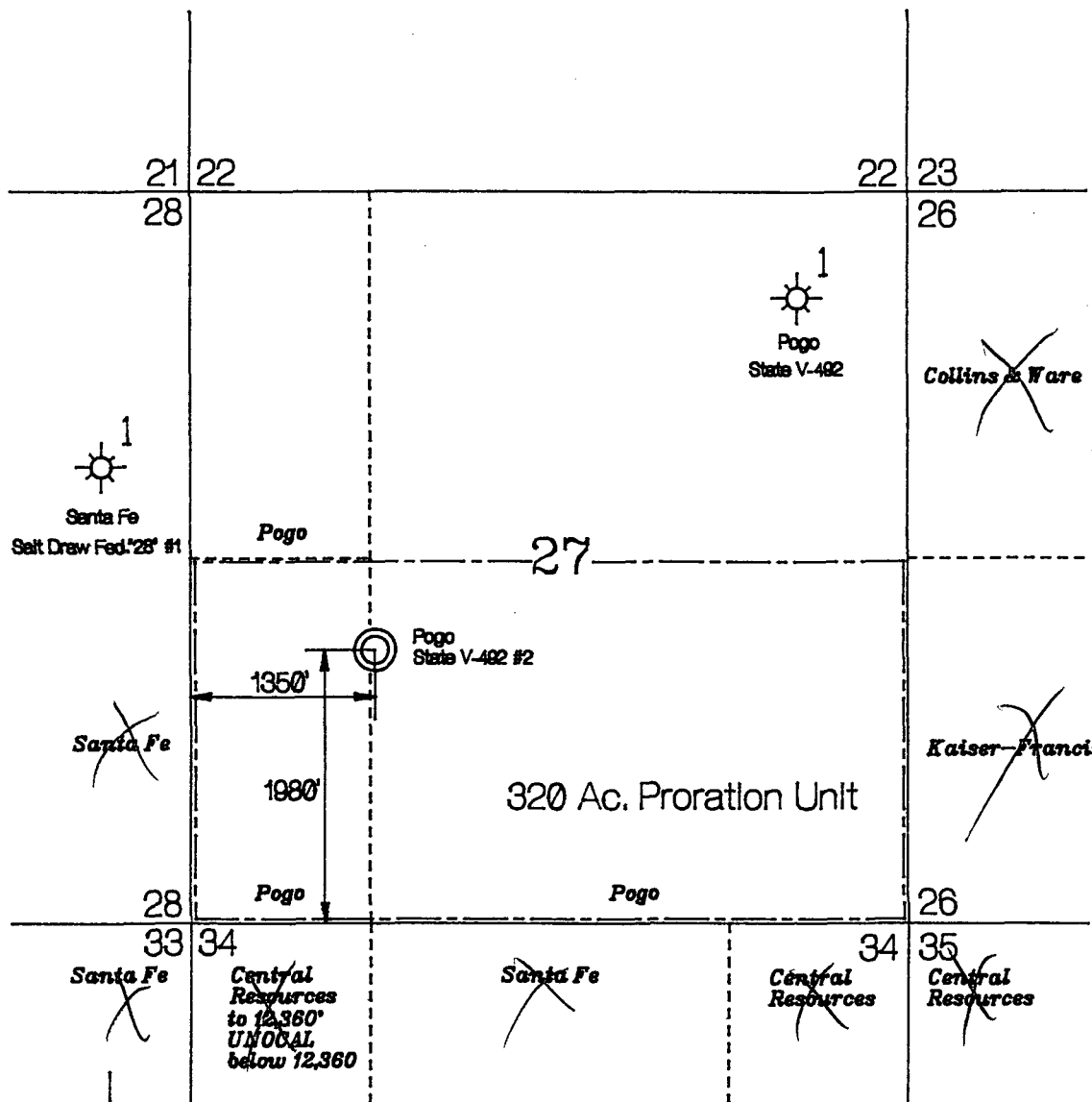
