Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated May 4, 1993 for a non-standard gas well location for your San Juan 30-6 Unit Well No. 48-R to be drilled 2295 feet from the South line and 725 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 27, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 equivalent of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
