Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application dated July 14, 1993, for a non-standard gas well location for the proposed Carracas Unit - PC 35-B Well No. 8 to be drilled 1340 feet from the North line and 1085 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 35, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, to test the Pictured Cliffs formation, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The NE/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
