
Reference is made to your application dated June 10, 1993 for an unorthodox oil well location in an existing standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool comprising the S/2 NE/4 of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which is presently dedicated to the Federal "MA" Well No. 8 located at a standard oil well location 2062 feet from the North line and 769 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 21.

By authority granted me under the provision of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8181-B, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.

Federal "MA" Well No. 10
2180' FNL - 2020' FEL (Unit G)

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate and produce the allowable assigned the 80-acre unit from both wells in any proportion.
