Reference is made to your application dated April 15, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for your Todd "23-J" Federal Well No. 14 located 2077 feet from the South line and 1600 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Undesignated Ingle Wells Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 23 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
