Dear Mr. Stephenson:

Reference is made to your application dated August 2, 1993 for a non-standard gas well location to be drilled 660 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 24, Township 22 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, to test the both the Morrow and Devonian formations, Eddy County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 24 is to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both intervals.

It is our understanding the proposed Apache "24" Federal Well No. 2 is within the Oil/Potash "R-111-P" Area, and is therefore subject to all applicable restrictions and rules therein.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox gas well location in is hereby approved.
