Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated September 2, 1993 for a non-standard gas well location for your Best Gas Com Well No. 1 drilled 730 feet from the North line and 1585 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 21, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, Basin Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lot 1, the NE/4 NE/4, S/2 NE/4, and SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 319.64-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(I) the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
