Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated September 7, 1993 for a non-standard gas well location for your San Juan Unit 28-7 Well No. 31-A to be drilled 670 feet from the North line and 1340 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 20, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Said well is to be an infill well, pursuant to Rule 2(b)2 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, to your San Juan 28-7 Unit Well 31, located in Unit N and is currently dedicated to the W/2 of said Section 20 being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Special Pool Rule, the above-described unorthodox infill gas well location is hereby approved.
