Dear Mr. McPhaul:

Reference is made to your application dated October 11, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Grayburg Jackson WBA Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-2990, dated October 27, 1965.

It is our understanding that the proposed Jackson "B" Well No. 35 is to be drilled 100 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson-Seven Rivers-Queen-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
