Dear Mr. Capps:

Reference is made to your application dated October 26, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the (Tenneco) Mesa Queen Unit Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3444, dated July 3, 1968.

It is our understanding that the proposed Mesa Queen Unit Well No. 36 is to be drilled 1710 feet from the South line and 15 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 16, Township 16 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Mesa Queen Pool, Mesa Queen Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Said well to be dedicated to a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 16.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
