Dear Mr. Basham:

Reference is made to your application dated January 27, 1994 to drill the L.L. McConnell Well No. 15 2310 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and complete in both the Blanco Mesaverde (Gas) and the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pools. Pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations applicable to both pools, said location is considered to be non-standard.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-4314-A, as amended, and Rule 2(c) of the General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil/gas well location is hereby approved.

The SW/4 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well to form a standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool and the S/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.
