Dear Ms. Brown:

Reference is made to your application dated February 15, 1994, for an unorthodox Tubb gas well location in an existing standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Tubb Oil and Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU presently has dedicated thereon the Brunson Argo Well No. 15 (API No. 30-025-10170) located at a standard gas well location 1880 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 10.


It is our understanding that the subject well in this application is currently completed in the Drinkard Pool at a standard location; however, upon issuance of this order, said well will be plugged back and recompleted in the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

***Brunson Argo Well No. 17(API No. 30-025-10178)
589' FNL - 731' FWL (Unit D) of said Section 10.***

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Tubb gas production from the Brunson Argo Well No. 15 with the Brunson Argo Well No. 17. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from both of wells in any proportion.
