Dear Mr.. Benson:

Reference is made to your application dated February 16, 1994 for an unorthodox gas well location for both the Basin-Dakota and Undesignated Largo-Gallup Pools for your proposed Rincon Unit Well No. 303. Said well is to be drilled 2180 feet from the North line and 535 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The S/2 of said Section 33 is to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both pools.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended; the applicable rules governing the Largo-Gallup Pool under Division Order No. R-2462, as amended; and General Rule 104.F(1), the aforementioned unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
