Per your letter dated October 12, 1994 informing this office of the recent reclassification from a "gas" well to an "oil" well in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool of your W. T. McComack Well No. 11 (API No. 30-025-06940), located at a standard oil well location 554 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 32, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. With said reclassification the 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 of said Section 32 should be terminate at this time.
