Dear Mr. Wood:

Reference is made to your application dated July 25, 1994 on behalf of Texahoma Oil and Gas Corporation for a non-standard coal gas well location for the Navajo "30" Well No. 1 to be drilled 520 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 30, Township 25 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 30 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
