Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated August 12, 1994 for an unorthodox coal gas well location for your proposed Florance Gas Com "A" Well No. 1-R to be drilled 760 feet from the North line and 570 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 22, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that said well is to be a replacement well for your Florance Gas Com "A" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-27145), located at a standard coal gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 1710 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 22, which is currently dedicated to the E/2 of said Section 22 being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
