Reference is made to your application dated December 14, 1994 and letter dated January 24, 1995 on behalf of the operator Devon Energy Corporation for a non-standard oil well location for its proposed Cactus State Well No. 7 to be drilled 984 feet from the North line and 2485 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Undesignated East Catclaw Draw-Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 16 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
