Reference is made to your application dated September 6, 1994, for an unorthodox oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Continental Langlie Jack Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3869, dated July 10, 1967.

It is our understanding that the proposed Langlie Jack Unit Well No. 19 is to be drilled 1330 feet from the South line and 1460 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 20, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Langlie Jack Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 20 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1), the above-described unorthodox well location is hereby approved.
