Dear Mr. Rittersbacher:

Reference is made to your application dated October 5, 1994 for a non-standard oil well location for your Lentini "1" Federal Well No. 15 to be drilled 1000 feet from the North line and 1125 feet from the West line (Lot 4/Unit D) of Section 1, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, East Herradura Bend-Delaware Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 39.51-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising Lot 4 (the NW/4 NW/4 equivalent) of said Section 1 which is currently dedicated to the Lentini "1" Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-27533), located at a standard oil well location 500 feet from the North line and 400 feet from the West line of said Section 1.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox well location is hereby approved.
