
Dear Mr. Baiar:

Reference is made to your application dated February 7, 1997 and to the Division's records on Division Administrative Order NSL-3484 for a non-standard prorated gas well location for the Rincon Unit Well No. 11E (API No. **30-039-25486**), located 2080 feet from the South line and 2410 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing 321.35-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising Lots 6 and 7, the E/2 SW/4, and the SE/4 (S/2 equivalent) of said Section 6.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of "*General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool/Special Rules and Regulations For The Basin-Dakota Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described well located at an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools is hereby approved.

All provisions of said Division Administrative Order NSL-3484 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
