Reference is made to your applications dated February 27, 1995 for three unorthodox oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within your Southeast Maljamar Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3134 dated October 14, 1966.

These three wells are to be located in Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Southeast Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Unit (SEMGSAU) Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
