
Dear Ms. Staley:

Reference is made to your application dated March 13, 1995 for a non-standard Gallup oil well location for your existing Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 83E (API No. 30-045-26011), which was drilled in 1984 and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 1120 feet from the North line and 1850 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 26, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that Amoco intends to properly plug the Dakota interval and recomplete said well up-hole into the Undesignated Simpson-Gallup Oil Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provision of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Simpson-Gallup Oil Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order no. R-2375, as amended, and Division Memorandum 4-86 dated June 2, 1986, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved. Further, the E/2 NW/4 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
