Dear Ms. Parker:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of the operator, Wiser Oil Company, by letter dated May 3, 1995 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Caprock Maljamar Unit Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-10094, dated April 5, 1994.

It is our understanding that the proposed Caprock Maljamar Unit Well No. 196 is to be drilled 2473 feet from the North line and 1259 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Caprock Maljamar Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Said well to be assigned to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 20 which is currently dedicated to the Caprock Maljamar Unit Well No. 181 (API No. 30-025-32044), located at a previously approved unorthodox oil well location (Division Administrative Order NSL-3261, dated June 23, 1993) 1408 feet from the North line and 1206 feet from the East line of said Section 20.


