Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to your application dated April 4, 1995 on behalf of the operator, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, for a non-standard gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool for your proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 151 to be drilled 1150 feet from the North line and 2205 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 33, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 33 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
