
Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated June 26, 1995 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Martin Well No. 2 (API No. **30-045-08980**) which was drilled in 1953 and completed in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of Section 34, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, which pursuant to the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 9 through 13, the SE/4 SW/4, and the W/2 SE/4 (S/2 equivalent) of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 321.87-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
