Reference is made to your application dated August 15, 1995 for a non-standard gas well location for your San Juan "29-7" Unit Well No. 151 to be drilled 2005 feet from the North line and 1030 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 35, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, to test the Undesignated South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
