Dear Mr. Buttross:

Reference is made to your application dated August 22, 1995 for an unorthodox oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the West Red Lake Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3469, dated August 13, 1968.

It is our understanding that the proposed West Red Lake Unit Well No. 57 (API No. 30-015-28539) is to be drilled 280 feet from the South line and 850 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Red Lake-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, West Red Lake Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 6 which is currently dedicated to the West Red Lake Unit Well No. 12 (API No. 30-015-00794), located at a standard oil well location 990 feet from the South and East lines of said Section 6.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox well location is hereby approved.
