Reference is made to your application dated September 7, 1995 for an unorthodox oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Keel West Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-2268, dated June 21, 1962.

It is our understanding that the proposed J.L. Keel "A" Well No. 19Y (API No. 30-015-28040) is to be drilled 1368 feet from the South line and 1367 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 7, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Keel West Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to an existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 7.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
