Dear Ms. Staley:

Reference is made to your application dated November December 14, 1995 for an unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde "infill" gas well location on an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, comprising the W/2 of said Section 15, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Said GPU is currently dedicated to the Michener "LS" Well No. 3 (API No. 30-045-07410) located at a standard gas well location 1090 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit M) of said Section 15.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "*General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox "infill" gas well location in said Section 15 is hereby approved:

Michener "LS" Well No. 3-A
1390' FNL - 1840' FWL (Unit F)

Further, both the Michener "LS" Well Nos. 3 and 3-A are to be dedicated to the subject GPU, further said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico.
