Reference is made to your applications dated December 19, 1995 and January 15, 1996 for four unorthodox oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within your Turner "A" (Lease) Grayburg-Jackson Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3185, as amended by Order Nos. R-3185-A, R-3528, and R-3528-A.
