
Reference is made to your application dated March 5, 1996 for an unorthodox "infill" oil well location on an existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for the Teaque-Blinebry Pool, comprising the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 22, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said 40-acre tract is currently dedicated to the C.E. Lamunyon Well No. 28 (API No. 30-025-22446) located at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the South line and 1780 feet from the West line of said Section 22.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox "infill" oil well location in said Section 22 is hereby approved:

C.E. Lamunyon Well No. 60
1300' FSL - 1340' FWL.
