Dear Mr. LeMay:

Enron Oil & Gas Company hereby requests administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 F(2) adopted on January 18, 1996 of an unorthodox well location for its Greenback State No. 2 Well to be drilled at a location 1980 feet from the North line and 1330 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

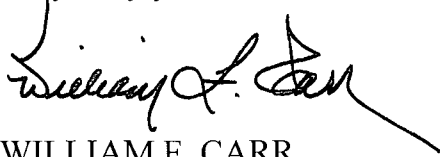
This unorthodox location in the Ellenburger formation is necessary for geological reasons. As shown on the Structure Map, attached hereto as Exhibit A, the location in the Ellenburger is necessary to maximize the porosity thickness penetrated by the well. The location will encounter 114 feet more porosity of 4% greater than a well drilled at a standard location.

This location encroaches only on immediately adjacent existing spacing units in the same pools and/or formations which are operated by Enron. There are no affected parties to whom notice of this application can be provided pursuant to Rule 1207 (A) (5).

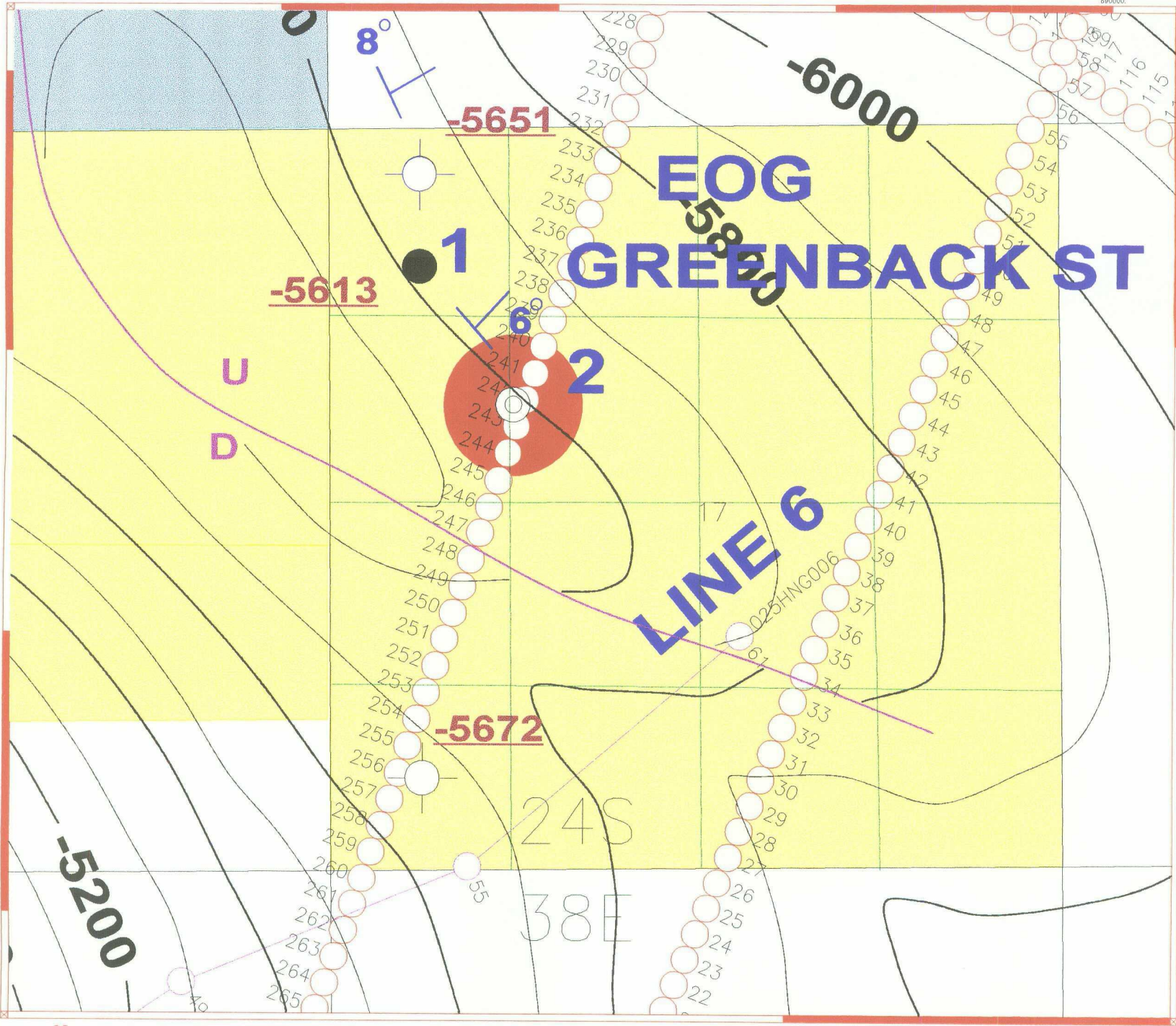

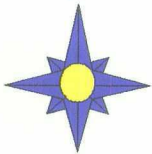
