Dear Ms. Staley:

Reference is made to your application dated August 9, 1996 for a non-standard gas well location to test the Ute Dome-Dakota Pool for your proposed Ute Indians "A" Well No. 25 to be drilled 930 feet from the South line and 260 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 2, Township 31 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of said Section 2 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
