Sorry I overlooked this before but there was a grammatical error on an NSL order.

This is the final paragraph of a draft order as it was submitted:

" Further, both the Schultz State Well Nos. 12 and 12-A are to be dedicated to the subject GPU, further said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico."

This paragraph is actually two sentences joined in error by a comma and misusing the word "further" for the conjunctive adverb "furthermore." I recommend one of the following corrections:

" Both the Schultz State Well Nos. 12 and 12-A are to be dedicated to the subject GPU; furthermore, said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico."
